- Bill Nason advised members that the range will be closed from August 24th to the 27th for an IPSC provincial championship shoot. The 24th & 25th will be for set up with competition on the 26th & 27th. Spectators are welcome for this dynamic shooting sport.
- Bill Nason asked all new members to remain following the meeting for range safety orientation.
