Minutes of Meeting March 16, 2017

Meeting Called To Order at: 7:10 p.m.

Adoption of minutes of meeting of February 21, 2017

Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer reported to those in attendance.

Old Business

- At the February meeting Dave Anderson asked how many members have black powder firearms. Dave Greene checked his records and found 34. Dave Anderson said he would follow up and see if there was enough interest to have a black powder event at the range.
- Dave Greene said he had a sign fabricated to remind members to ensure the sea can is locked before they leave the range. Blake Tibbetts said he had been advised by the snow plow operator that the main gate had once again not been latched. Those responsible are reminded that they will forfeit their membership & be banned for ignoring club rules.

New Business

- The membership was advised by the executive that the club has changed insurance providers from the Shooting Federation of Canada to Holman Insurance. There is a significant cost savings and the price is fixed for the year and does not increase with membership numbers. The method used by the SFC had become expensive and cumbersome given the size of the club membership.
- Dave Greene said he had forwarded funds to the Fredericton Trap & Skeet club for the season's upcoming shoots. Payment is now due from anyone who has registered to attend. There are still places open on the squads, contact Dave if interested.
- Dave Greene once again reminded members that the 2016 financial report is available for review.
- Dave Greene said the restricted firearms courses for April, May, and June are all full. If you wish to attend in the future you must contact the office of the CFO, otherwise they will not organize another class. Several local non restricted courses will be taking place in the fall, contact the DNR to register.
- Dave Greene said he had been to the range several times last week and collected hundreds of .223 cartridge cases that someone had not bothered to pick up. Members are reminded that if the range is not kept clean the property owner can order us off the land with 30 days notice. Dave also found paper in the garbage bags and metal in the burn barrels – this is not rocket science.
- Dave Greene announced that September 9th had been selected for our annual Scout Appreciation day. Following the poor support given to the event last year by the membership, with only 6 members present, Dave created a list of tasks that need to have a member take ownership of before we will commit to having the event this year. Contact Dave if you wish to volunteer.
- Blake Tibbetts said that club member Jody Waring would be holding an IPSC black badge holster course April 22nd & 23rd. The cost is \$130, requires a minimum 9 mm caliber pistol, and 500 rounds of ammunition. Contact Blake or Jody for more information.
- Steve Wilbur asked if the club was still affiliated with the Royal New Brunswick Rifle Association (RNBRA). There is a discount for individual membership if you belong to an affiliated club. Dave Greene replied that the club is an affiliate member.
