Old Business

- Bill Nason said the CFO had approved our new pistol bays at the range but our 100/200 yard range had failed inspection. The problems noted are that the angle is too shallow on the back stop plus it has erosion damage and the left berm is not high enough & not 1 meter thick at the top. Kemal Debly has been contacted for advice on how to correct the deficiencies. Dave Green explained how we are going to use jute netting and grass seed to prevent future damage.
- Bill Nason read a letter of thanks from Dianne Gould for hosting the recent IPSC provincial championships at our range. There were 35 competitors in attendance for the two day event. Special thanks were expressed to Blake Tibbetts, Scott Lockhart, Roy Byers, Phil Armstrong, & Marvin Rathburn.
- Dave Greene read the results of the recent Turkey Shoot. 50 yard standing winner was Tye Barter with a 37/50 front score for a \$20 Sobeys card & \$25 cash prize, winner of the back score was Steve Tibbetts with a 43 for a \$25 cash prize. Winner of the 100 yard bench shoot with a 38/50 on the front and 20 back score was Dave Greene for a \$20 Sobeys card & \$50 cash prize.
- Dave Greene said Graeme Scott has graciously donated his recently won .22 rifle back to the club for members to use at rimfire shoots.
- Dave Greene said the new AT-50 Battue thrower and cart has arrived.

New Business

- Dave Greene reminded members that the 100/200 yard range is out of service until repaired and inspected satisfactorily by the CFO. Any members found using the range during closure will be expelled from the club.
- Dave Greene said our latest Scout Appreciation day was well attended and enjoyed by all. We received a letter of support from Cabela's Moncton along with a gift card, hats, multi tools, and coupons. The gift card was used to purchase 2,000 rounds of .22 ammo.
