Old Business

- Dave Greene said he would contact the insurance company this week to have the policy clarified and corrected if needed. New Business

- Dave Greene said volunteers are still needed for the Scout Appreciation day event on September 8th. A list of tasks was circulated to the membership. To date we have only 3 members who have said they would attend. Without further assistance from members we will have to cancel this popular event. We have received half our grant money from the NBWTF for the event. The July bank statement was received and balanced. A thank you and receipt was received for our donation in memory of Jim Porter to the SJRH foundation. The Dana Russell memorial shotgun shoot will take place September 15th and registration is required. Cost is \$60 for 100 clays and a barbeque lunch. Prizes include a Stevens 555 O/U 12 gauge shotgun and a gun vault. We will hold an open range day for the general public October 6 with free admission, shooters will only have to pay for ammunition. All proceeds will go to the Joshua group. All club RSO's are needed to assist with the event. Bass Pro Shops in Moncton was contacted for an ammo donation for the Scout event but they replied they were not taking any more funding requests for 2018; Dave then asked for support for the 2019 event. There may be Giant Hogweed growing near the main gate, Dave said he would contact a knowledgeable club member to make an identification.
- Dave Anderson asked if there had been any consideration of a membership cap. Dave Greene replied that there had been a discussion regarding one but no action was taken.
