Minutes of Meeting February 13, 2018

Treasurer's Report:

Old Business

- Dave Greene introduced our new Membership Secretary Tye Barter. Tye stepped up to fill the open position following the January annual general meeting. We are glad to have him join the executive team as the club continues to grow and so does the administrative workload.
- Dave Greene reminded members that shotgun shells will only be ordered after a member places a deposit on the case. The deadline for orders is the end of February, an email has been sent out to the membership. Blake Tibbetts said he has orders for 17 pounds of powder from Higginson's but will only place it if he had 20 pounds. Contact Blake if you wish to order powder or primers.
- Dave Greene reiterated the need to properly print full names in the logbook and not to line up with the times shown on the page – just start at the top. Guest names are also required.

New Business

- Dave Greene said the January bank statement was received & balanced. A letter of thanks was mailed to Mr. John Irving for his generous donation to the club. A donation was made to the Heart & Stroke foundation in memory of Troy Harnish's brother.
- Dave Greene found clays placed on the ground in front of the target stands on the 100 yard line, despite all the warnings we have issued about this practice. - Dave Greene reviewed the 2017 income statement.
- Dick Platt asked about the state of plans to modify the range property. Response from the executive was that we are still trying to obtain permission from the property owners.
- Dave Greene said that shotgun shoot prepaid cards are available for \$110 or \$55 for a half card. Juniors are half price.
- Bill Nason said that Jody Waring and Jim McGee were making plans for more organized shoots this year as the ones last year were very popular. They were asking for dates to be confirmed for our regular events (Scout Appreciation, Dana Russell, Youth Event). Dave Greene said the events would take place probably in June (Youth) & September. Dave added that he had already submitted our application to the NBWTF for the Scout event.
- Dave Greene reminded members that we will be sending two 5 man squads to the Fredericton shotgun shoots. There are still a few openings, contact Dave if you wish to attend.
- Bill Nason asked all new members to remain after the meeting for range safety orientation.
