Treasurer's Report:

Old Business

- Dave Greene said the corporate credit cards had been located and he has activated his without issue. We had three additional renewal days where the hall was rented the first week of January to ensure members had ample opportunity to sign up for another year or exchange keys without a long wait and a big lineup. 134 members took advantage. The guest waiver form is now available in the main seacan along with a container for completed papers; members are once again reminded they are REQUIRED to have guests fill out the form and they must witness and sign it as well. The new contact email system is working well and member feedback has been positive regarding the professional appearance.
- A member asked if he is required to have his son complete the guest waiver if he goes to the range. It is not necessary to have family members fill out the form provided they are spouses or under 18 years of age, as noted in the clubs regulations appendix #1.

New Business

- Dave Greene said the bank statement for December was received and balanced. The income statement for 2018 has been completed and copies were circulated for member review. Dave has contacted the RNBRA requesting \$100 for youth training of biathlon athletes. Requests for quotations have been sent to multiple groups and companies for this year's club insurance. Range usage for 2018 was 309 days with 2066 trips to the facility for an average of 4.8 trips per member, down slightly from 2017. Dave made available the schedule for restricted and non restricted firearms courses for the new year; members are reminded that there is a link on the club website that shows the schedule and there is also a link to sign up.
- Wayne Johnson asked Dave Greene about the biggest expense of the income statement, range maintenance. Dave went through item by item the costs to purchase supplies and materials to keep the range viable.
