Old Business

- Dave Greene asked that all members go online and sign the e petition 2341 to the Trudeau government regarding the banning of all semi automatic firearms which are described as “military-style assault rifles”, a term for an item that does not exist. This gross over reach by the government bypasses the democratic process by using an Order In Council and allows confiscation of private property with no legal justification. Presently only 2300 out of 68000 PAL holders in New Brunswick have signed; we must do better or we will lose our firearms. Details are posted on the January News section of the club website.

New Business

- Dave Greene said the bank statement for December has been received and balanced. Only 57% of the emails sent out by the club in December were opened – members are reminded that these emails often detail when the range is closed, etc. and they should be read, not discarded. A letter was sent to Bass Pro Shops asking for donations of prizes for our annual Scout Appreciation Day in September.
