Minutes of Meeting July 10, 2018

Old Business

- Bill Nason reminded members that our annual Youth Shoot event at the range would be taking place July 14th with the 15th as a rain date. Dave Greene asked for a volunteer to pick up a 10 lb bag of charcoal and drill holes into the center of the briquettes; Bill said he would look after it and also food and drinks for the attendees.
- Dave Greene said he had been unable to follow up with the insurance company due to family and health issues but planned on doing so as soon as he is able.
- Dave Greene said there were still openings for the Browning shotgun shoot in August. Please contact Dave or Bill if you wish to attend.
- Dave Greene announced that there would be a Turkey Shoot on July 12th at the range using novelty targets that consist of scoring grids on the front and random grids on the back. Targets will be sold for \$5 each and the shooter with the best score on the front of the target will get half the money collected plus a \$20 Sobeys gift card and the shooter with the best score on the back will get the other half. One round will be from 50 yards standing, the other 100 yards from a bench. You will have 3 minutes to fire 5 rounds. Please come with your rifles already sighted in as you will not be allowed to do so prior to the shoot.

New Business

- Dave Greene said our grant application to the NBWTF for our Scout Appreciation day had been approved but with a 15% reduction as the group has done across the board. The bank Statement for June was received and balanced. We have received a thank you card and official receipt from River View Manor Foundation in memory of Jim Ball. Anti C-71 stickers have been purchased and are available for \$2 each.
- Dave Greene said he had received a phone call from a member complaining that the grass was too long at the 100 yard line. Dave advised the caller that the lawn mower and grass trimmer are located in the main seacan for all members to be able to use as needed. As a general reminder we are a volunteer organization and that means that all members are expected to contribute to the operation of the club, including maintenance of the range. We are not a business and the executive are not employees.
