### Old Business

- Dave Greene was contacted by a Scout leader and told that they have not resumed activities but hope to do so sometime in September; unfortunately this is too late in the year for us to host an event.
- FSSI received national recognition from the CCFR for our generous donation to help fight the Trudeau government firearms confiscation plan. To view the segment, please see the link on the "news" section of the club website.
- 6 members have come forward following our call for volunteers to become firearms course instructors to assist the DNR in meeting demand from new shooters. 1 member is already certified. Many thanks to these members for answering the call.

### New Business

- Dave Greene said the bank statement for June has been received and balanced.
- The date for our youth shoot has been set for August 21<sup>st</sup>. The event is open to children and grandchildren of members so they can be introduced to firearms in a controlled environment. As always we need volunteers with scope-sighted .22 rifles to serve as range safety officers, and others to assist in the operation of the event. Please contact any member of the executive if you wish to help or attend.
- Dave Greene asked if there was any interest in holding an open range or ladies day shoot this year. Bill Nason said he would inquire with the Hampton club to see what their plans are regarding similar activities so we do not conflict.
- Dave Greene passed around a sample T shirt bearing the club logo to gauge interest in ordering a number for sale. The shirt was good quality and well received.
- Dave Greene has been asked to serve on the board of the NBWTF. Dave has accepted the position and we know he will serve with integrity and distinction.
- Bill Nason said he had ordered 30,000 small pistol primers and they sold out almost immediately. He is sourcing another 50,000 and at least 20,000 are already spoken for. He has a small quantity of large pistol primers available please email Bill if you are interested.
- Member Greg Matthews asked for clarification regarding the need for an ATT to move a firearm to a place other than the range. Under bill C71 ATT's are now required if you need to visit a gunsmith, etc. The national firearms center must be contacted to obtain the ATT. This change does nothing to stop criminal transportation of firearms but puts a legitimate firearm owner under a time-critical deadline to transport before their ATT expires and they can be charged. Liberal crime-fighting at it's virtue-signaling best.
- Blake Tibbetts asked if there was any interest in a bulk purchase of powder as he was planning to place an order in the near future. Please contact Blake if you are interested.
- Bill Nason said 9 mm ammo is extremely scarce and prices are terrible at over \$20 a box. If anyone sees it available for reasonable prices we can make a very large order. Please contact Bill if you see a deal.
- Dave Greene reminded members that shotgun nights take place every Wednesday, weather permitting, and Blake Tibbetts holds .22 rimfire shoots on Thursday nights.
- Bill Nason asked new members to remain after the meeting for range safety orientation.
