Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer's report was read to members in attendance.

Old Business

- Rob Roy read a number of old business items Dave Greene wished to be noted. Squad members are still being accepted for various shotgun shoots at Fredericton Trap & Skeet, contact Dave or Bill Nason if you wish to take part. Dave followed up again on June 4th with the property owners regarding our request and said there was nothing new to report. Mitchell explained that there is a "participant exclusion" clause that means any member using the range who gets injured is not eligible for compensation. Members demanded that the policy be corrected by the executive. Many thanks to Mitch for his valuable services to the club.

The NBWTF acknowledged receipt of our request for a grant for our 2018 Scouts Appreciation Day.
