Old Business

- Bill Nason advised members the steel plate target that had been placed at the 25/50 yard line for rimfire and handgun use had been severely damaged by a center fire rifle or slug. The target had just been repaired a week prior. It will be removed. A lengthy discussion followed on possible ways to determine who was responsible. Members who violate club rules are reminded that the penalties for such behavior are serious – they will be barred for life, the CFO will be advised they were expelled, and no other local gun clubs will permit them to join.
- Bill Nason attended the handgun marksmanship clinic that Jody Waring conducted on Monday night. He said every shooter present was rewarded with better groups by the end of the session. Jody will be conducting another clinic later this summer.
