Old Business

It was an enjoyable outing for the youths & we thank those club members who volunteered their time for this worthwhile event. New Business

- John Kelly said the bank statement for May has been received & balanced; all bills to date are paid up except a visa invoice due June 23rd. National Range Day has 93 individuals registered but the weekend weather looks troubling; it was decided to wait until Thursday to see if the event can be held on Saturday or Sunday, otherwise we may have to cancel for this year. There is a replacement door for the damaged one on the outhouse; Bill Nason said he would find members to install it. There are three rolls of heavy conveyor belting that need to be moved next to the main seacan; ideally they should be cut into 24" x 24" squares for target stands if members are willing to step up – use a large square & sharp utility knife. The green safety flag in the pistol bay needs to be replaced, member Aldo Pascon volunteered to perform the task.
- Dave Greene had a question for member Frank Osmon regarding restricted firearms courses given the federal Liberals looming bill C-21; Frank said he was still putting on the training as there has been no instructions to stop as of yet.
- Bill Nason said the club will be hosting the RNBRA practical pistol championship July 22<sup>nd</sup>, please contact Jody Waring if you plan to attend, registration is \$25, email has been sent.
- A member had a question regarding his status relating to restricted firearms as he underwent the then-new federal safety course many years ago which combined both non-restricted & restricted firearms; he stated that he believed he was grandfathered-in as being able to possess restricted firearms. Frank Osmon stated, to the best of his knowledge, this was the case as long as the member had never let his PAL expire the training was still valid.
- Bill Nason asked new members to remain after the meeting for range safety orientation.
