Minutes of Meeting March 14, 2023

Meeting Called To Order at: 7:20 p.m.

Adoption of minutes of meeting of February 14, 2023

Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer reported to those in attendance.

Old Business

- A member asked Dave Greene where they should buy ammo since Bass Pro Shops has stopped supporting our youth shooting events. Dave suggested Canadian Tire West and/or The Gun Dealer in McAdam – both businesses provide support for our club events.
- Dave Greene said he had received a response from provincial minister of public safety Kris Austin regarding his desire to alter backslope requirements in the range construction guidelines. Minister Austin said consultations would be held around the province on reviewing the document “Standards for design and construction of shooting ranges”. Dave Greene & Paul Holder will attend the March 22nd meeting in Saint John to represent the club. Dave then elaborated on the need to correct the provincial document to correspond with the federal one as a slope angle of 35 degrees is impossible to achieve; also, range inspections are seemingly performed without standards for pass/fail & arbitrary decisions made on-the-spot without any written documentation or rule.
- Dave Greene again asked for volunteers to support the Scout Appreciation day shoot to be held May 13th (May 14th rain date). At least 20 volunteers are needed for the event.
- Bill Nason said the National Range Day event in support of the CCFR will take place June 3rd and volunteers are needed to form the committee & help at the range on the day of the shoot. Trevor Little, Bill Nason, & Dave Greene said they would serve on the committee; more members are needed. Please contact Dave or Bill to assist this very popular shoot.

New Business

- Dave Greene said the bank statement for February has been received & balanced. The RNBRA has approved funding for our Scout Appreciation Day & Youth Shoot. A member has requested the door on the portapotty be repaired/replaced as it no longer latches closed; a member attending the meeting said he had a contact with JTR and would find out the cost of a replacement. Bass Pro Shops refused our request for a donation of ammo for our Scout event – we have informed the CCFR & drafted a rebuttal letter. We now have direct deposit for EFT's sent to Dave's email so a password is no longer required. Our insurance broker (Holman Insurance) provided a quote for this season that is only \$17 more than last year; Dave made a motion that we accept the quote, seconded by Dan Adams, motion carried unanimously.
- Bill Nason asked new members to remain after the meeting for range safety orientation.
