Format this year is basic firearms – bolt-action rifles only, optics of any kind, caliber .223 and greater; shotgun pump-action or break open; no semi-autos, pump with tube magazine only, no speed loaders, 20 or 12 gauge; pistol 9mm minimum, iron sights only, no compensators, dots, or barrel ports. Registration via email or Practiscore
- FSS will also host an IPSC level 2 match for Provincial Classic Division (Colt .45 cal.) Sunday October 22. All divisions welcome but awards only for competitors shooting in Classic; Black Badge mandatory.
- Dave Greene said the Dana shoot returned over \$700 to the club and has in the last 11 years contributed over \$8000; thanks to Dave for overseeing this popular event.
