Minutes of Meeting October 8th, 2024

Adoption of minutes of meeting September 10th, 2024

Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer reported to those in attendance.

Old Business

- Dave Greene said the Dana Russell Memorial Shotgun Shoot was rescheduled to September 14th. The donation made to the SPCA in memory of Leon Hayward's wife Marilyn has been acknowledged by the family & we have received a receipt.

New Business

- Dave Greene said the bank statement for September has been received and balanced, all bills are paid; John Leonard accepted a 3 year membership in exchange for bush-hogging of the range. The Dana Russell Memorial Shotgun Shoot took place September 14<sup>th</sup> with 23 shooters participating. Stan McGrattan placed first with a score of 85/100, John Leonard was second with 81/100, and Jim Harper was third with 79/100. David Goodfellow won the Stevens 555 O/U shotgun draw & also won the raffle for a case of shotgun shells. The event returned over \$600 to the club; thanks to those participants, organizers, and club volunteers. Wednesday night shotgun shoots over the past summer totaled 21 events with an average of 13 shooters & an average of 3 lines shot. The total was 834 lines shot, returning a net of over \$1000 to the club.
- Mike Delaney said the need to replace the railway ties at the 25/50 target line falls at a bad time of year, volunteer wise, as most members are busy with hunting season and the weather/day length is not very accommodating. This work detail will likely have to wait until spring.
- Dave Greene said he receives detailed reports from Constant Contact, our email provider, and it shows some members are unsubscribing from the service & others simply delete the emails without opening them. Members are reminded that this is the primary method used by the club to communicate important information such as range closures, organized shoots that will leave ranges unavailable, etc. Please ensure that you are able to receive the messages and are not labeling them as spam or junk; it is for your own benefit.
- Member Greg Matthews mentioned before the meeting that he has found the inside 200 yard range gate closed & locked with no members present & the green flag raised. It appears some members do not understand the procedure to use this gate; it is to be closed and locked **ONLY when shooting is taking place from the 200 yard firing line**. If you are unsure of the procedure review the range safety orientation on the club website. Thanks to Greg for mentioning this matter.
- Bill Nason asked new members to remain after the meeting for range safety orientation.
